Hi everyone, the 2013 membership year is closed as of August 31st. We finished the year with 349 active members. Membership for 2014 will start on October 1st. The price for most memberships will be increasing by \$10 for most of the membership types for 2014. We held the line for a number of years and absorbed the last NCGA dues increase, but we must now increase our membership fees to continue to maintain the level of service as we have in the past. As of this writing, the Diamond level benefits and fees have not been finalized but are expected soon and will be updated on the membership form when it becomes available. As always, you can renew your regular membership or sign up a new member and add the Diamond membership at a later date. If you purchase the Diamond upgrade through the pro shop, they can give you the member package at the time of payment. Most everything in that package is only good for dates in the 2014 calendar year.



Tournament Director's Message

RGC members,

There are some proposed changes coming in the 2014 RGC golf season that will make for an even better experience as far as tournaments are concerned. In response to the "Play it Forward" suggestion set forth by the N.C.G.A., the White tees will be opened up to anyone who wants to play from them regardless of age or index for both regular and tournament play. The rule that will remain the same is that once you choose a tee location to play from you must play that tee location for the rest of that calendar year. There will be exceptions, i.e., the NCGA qualifiers will still be played from the Blue tees for men, and from the Red tees for women. There will also be a change in the Championship flight of the RGC Club Championship. It is being proposed that all players who qualify in the Championship flight will play from the Blue tees only.

Another proposed change is that the 4-Ball Qualifier and the Senior 4-Ball qualifier, will now become two separate tournaments played on two different dates. The 4-Ball qualifier is open to all members, and the Senior 4-Ball Qualifier will be restricted to those members 55 years of age or older, the same requirement as the NCGA now observes. Also, the 3 Club tournament will once again be part of the tournament schedule and the Day on the Oaks weekday events will continue to be played during the Summer months. Be sure and check all dates on the 2014 Tournament Schedule when it appears around the end of the year.

The 2014 elections will be held at the September Open meeting. The candidates for 2014 are:

Members- at-Large (2 seats available) and the candidates for the two seats are:

Rules Committee Message

Red vs. Yellow Stakes

Many questions are asked about the difference between yellow staked hazards and red staked hazards. We certainly have both at Diamond Oaks. It is not the size, shape or location of the hazard that dictates your relief, it is the color of the stakes. (Rule 26-1)

Yellow stakes: These indicate a water hazard, such as the lake in front of the 10th tee. If your ball enters an area marked with yellow stakes your relief, *under penalty of one stroke*, is either (1) stroke and distance playing the ball as close to where the original ball was last played, or (2) dropping the ball behind the water hazard keeping the point where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard directly between the hole and the spot where the ball is dropped.

So, if you hit your tee shot into the lake from the tee on 10, you can:

- Play it as it lies,
- re-tee from the tee box hitting 3 or
- move up closer to the lake and drop a ball keeping the point where the original ball crossed the margin of the lake in line with the hole, also hitting 3.

Red stakes: These stakes indicate a lateral hazard, such as the water on either side of hole 3, the waste area to the left of hole 6, or the concrete channel down the side of 17. If your ball has entered an area marked with red stakes, the player may play it as it lies or, *under penalty of one stroke*, (1) go back to the spot where the original shot was played, (2) drop the ball on the far side of the hazard, or (3) drop a ball within 2 club lengths of the point where the ball entered the hazard, no closer to the hole. (See decision 26-1/15 for a graphic description.)

So, if you hit your tee shot into the water on the left of hole 3, you can:

- Play it as it lies
- re-tee from the tee box, hitting 3,
- drop a ball behind the pond as describe for a yellow staked water hazard above, hitting 3, or
- drop a ball within 2 club lengths of where the ball entered the hazard, no closer to the hole, hitting 3.

The last option is the most practical and, in most instances, the best option.

Play fast and have fun.
