SECRETARY'S MESSAGE

Hi everyone, the 2015 membership year is closed as of August 31st. We finished the year with 287 active members. Membership for 2016 will start on October 1st. If you know of anyone that would like to be a member, but hasn't yet signed up, we have a special new member promotion going on as of the Invitational Tournament. Through September 30th, they can join at the existing member renewal price of \$80 during that time frame. They can sign up on Pay Pal and use the "member renewal before December 15th" link. They can also download a copy of the membership application at the www.rosevillegolfclub.com website and submit or mail it with payment, or drop it in the box at Diamond Oaks.

There are also forms available at Diamond Oaks in the pro shop. Just line through the 2015 date and put in 2016. NCGA closed entries from September 1st to 30th, so I already know it will be for 2016. If they join now, they can have the benefit of a 15 month membership as their membership would activate for the rest of 2015 and all of 2016. There are still several tournaments before the end of the year, and new members can get a jump on qualifying rounds for the major tournaments to be eligible to play and compete for those tournaments individually or as part of your team. See the major tournament qualification section on the tournament schedule on line or at the course.

As of this writing, the Diamond level benefits and fees have not been finalized but are expected soon and will be updated on the membership form when it becomes available. As always, you can renew your regular membership or sign up a new member and add the Diamond membership at a later date. If you purchase the Diamond upgrade through the pro shop, they can give you the member package at the time of payment. Most everything in that package is only good for dates in the 2016 calendar year anyway, so it doesn't matter if you do that part later.
