We made it through a great 2018 schedule with no rain outs. I appreciated all the positive feedback for the results being out so quickly. I appreciate those of you who helped catch my mistakes, which helped me also throughout the year.

I have now gathered enough information as to who most of you like to play with, but please make sure you fill out your entry form with that information and/or contact Charlie and myself with any special requests. Based on the list of players provided by the Tournament Bookkeeper, I create the tee sheets for all events. So, if you would like an earlier tee time get your entries in early. If you ever need an early or late time specifically,

please notify me when you submit your entry and I will try to accommodate you. Some of the major tournaments require that your tee time is based on score and probably not be able to accommodate you for those tournaments after the first day, but I will do my best.

This will be the first year of the Roseville Golf Club's tournaments held at Diamond Oaks, where men will play from the Palmer Tees and women play from the Red or Palmer tees. Because the course has been re-rated the course slope has changed, so in most cases those players who had played from the White Tees will be adjusted up a minimum of 1 stroke. We will be using the Palmer tees for the full 2019 schedule and vote at the September 2019 open meeting on the continuation for the 2020 season. HANDICAPPER'S MESSAGE



Hi everybody, I will be your new/old Handicap Chairperson. Let me give you some background information about myself. I was previously a Board Member from 1998-2004, 2006-2011, 2015 and 2017 including previously as Tournament Director 1999-2000 and 2015, President in 2002 and Handicapper 2006-2011. I also recently served on Committees for Tournament, Handicap and Rules.

Diamond Oaks has a new set of tees. These are the Palmer tees. The Palmer tees have a Course Rating of 69.2, Slope of 120 and Yardage is 5948 yards. At all Roseville Golf Club tournaments held at Diamond Oaks, men will play from the Palmer tees and women will play from the Red or White tees. This year, men will not be playing from the Blue or White tees. The only exceptions are the Firecracker and the Club Championship. For the Club Championship, the Champion Flight plays from Blue tees for men and White tees for women. All other flights men will play from the Palmer tees and women will play from the Red or White tees.
