TOURNAMENT BOOKKEEPER'S MESSAGE

Hello members. We are continuing to proceed with caution during tournaments. These safeguards have altered the way we take and receive money for our tournaments.

1. The golf shop will not be allowed to put entries into the RGC box at Diamond Oaks.

2. All entries will be handled online through Member Planet, Zelle or Venmo. (Please note on the form what tournament you are signing up for and who you would like to play with, in the note or memo box).

3. The prize fund will be handled the same way as before. The money won will be applied to the member's account at Diamond Oaks Golf shop.

4. We will be going back to the old way of doing skins with a signup sheet that will be posted on the tournament board (in the breeze way) before the start of the tournaments. We will collect the fees when you turn in your scorecard and have the skins ready by the end of the tournament. Obviously, if members wish to continue to pay ahead of time online, that is still acceptable.

HANDICAP CHAIRPERSON AND CLUB AMBASSADOR'S MESSAGE

Hello everybody.

Just a reminder, if you haven't done this already, you will not be able to post online in the future.

We have received the following message from NCGA regarding posting scores:

In order to improve data security and golfer privacy, golfers will need to create a digital profile to access the GHIN mobile app and ghin.com beginning in January 2021. Shared emails on multiple accounts will not be supported. Adult users are required to have a unique email address to create a digital profile for access to

the GHIN products.

What does this mean? When you post a score online or through the NCGA App, you will no longer be able to access it using your GHIN. You will need to create a profile using your email address. There will be a grace period for a short time for the NCGA App and posting online through the NCGA browser. The only other way to post is through the kiosk at golf courses. However, because of COVID, not all golf courses have their kiosks available.

NCGA has an online travel and entertainment portal that has discounts for hotels, tickets to sporting events, theater and concerts. to access, <https://ncga.org/ncga-go/>.

RULES CHAIRPERSON

Hello RGC!

I hope everyone is having a great season at the mid-point. I have three points that have come up recently.

Course conditions are improving, however, we still have challenges with some sink holes, overwatering and bare spots. I mark the course before all tournaments for ground under repair and penalty areas, so if you have areas you want me to address, let me know. Remember that you always get relief from standing water and the areas listed in the Local Rules. I'm afraid that doesn't help on some of the bare spots, but we all play the same course.

Music is new one for most of us on the course. Under the last USGA Rules revision, Players Equipment, Rule 4.3.a.4 states that listening to audio or watching video is allowed as long as it is unrelated to the competition and is not being done to eliminate distractions or help with the swing tempo. However, the Player Conduct, Rule 1.2 requires consideration for others in your foursome. It might also distract players on an adjoining hole. My opinion is maybe it is best not to break out the Zeppelin during tournament play. But if this is your thing, be considerate, because I'll probably hear about it if you aren't.

Reminder: For speed of play, on Hole #10 we are playing a drop zone for any errant tee shot into the water. This zone is behind the Red Tee markers wherever they are set. We are not marking the course as this is only for RGC play. Just play the ball down and behind the markers and you're good to hit #3.
