## HANDICAPPER'S REPORT



Hi everybody, this is a reminder that all tournament scores are posted by the Handicap Committee.

Please notify the Tournament Director and Handicap Chairperson if you wish to change to Blue, Palmer or White Tees.

There is a new method being used by the Club to determine Tournament Handicaps. It is calculated by using the two lowest of your four most recent tournament scores at Diamond Oaks within the last calendar year. I have found a simpler way of calculating your own tournament

handicaps using the MyNCGA App. If you follow the steps below, you can do your own calculation. When you open the App, you will see a down arrow next to "Scores – 20 Most Recent". Click on that down arrow and scroll down to "Scores – Competition" then click there. It will bring up all your tournament scores. Look for the 4 most recent scores at Diamond Oaks. Using the 2 lowest differentials, add them together and divide by 2. In the example below, the two lowest differentials are 20.7 and 23.5. Added together that equals 44.2. 44.2 divided by 2 equals 22.1. The Tournament Handicap Index is 22.1. You then may take that index and look up the Course Handicap here <https://www.usga.org/course-handicap-calculator.html>.

## RULES CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT



Hello RGC members,

I would like to thank Paul Wilson, RGC President, for entrusting me as your Rules Chairperson for the remainder of the 2022 golf year. For those who don't know me, I was a member of the club from 1975-85 and rejoined the club in 2010, following retirement as a Land Use Planner for the County of Nevada. I live in Grass Valley and golf regularly on the weekdays at Diamond Oaks and WoodCreek.

I was first elected to the Board as a Member at Large for 2021-22. I am usually at the course for all tournaments selling raffle tickets, so please stop by and say hello.

Diamond Oaks has held up well with the mild winter. The course conditions are continually improving. Many of the old tree stumps have been removed. My goal this year is to keep the membership informed of any updated rules using the RGC shadow box and marking problem areas on the course before most tournaments. I'd recommend that all members review the "Playing Procedures," found at the RGC website: <http://rosevillegolfclub.com>. Also, "Conditions of Play" should be reviewed before each tournament.

The RGC encourages a prompt pace of play. Each round is to be completed in 4 hours and 30 minutes or less, or within 15 minutes of the group that finishes before your group. It's important that each group keep up with the forward group, so everyone has a consistent pace of play. No one enjoys a rabbit race at the end of the round. The following is a link to the NCGA website for Pace of Play Tips. <https://ncga.org/rules/pace-ofplay/>. Finally, there is a maximum three (3) minute search time looking for your golf ball. After this 3-minute period expires, the ball is deemed lost. Player must take stroke-and distance relief by adding one penalty stroke (Rule 14.6). I look forward to being the RGC Rules Chairperson for the 2022 golf year.
