Open Meeting

Called to order at 7:04 p.m. by Joe Santone.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT – Joe thanked those in attendance at the tree planting in memory of Skip Orr. He also read the minutes from the March Board meeting which were approved by the board.

VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT – The Christmas fund is approximately \$750.

SECRETARY'S REPORT – Latest numbers show we have 438 active members.

TREASURER'S REPORT – Bank and cash accounts; Edward Jones Savings \$5,396.56 RGC account \$19,725.08 for a total bank and cash of \$25,121.64.

TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR'S REPORT – Bryan informed the membership that there will be a Senior flight starting with the Memorial Tournament. Players 55 years and older qualify for this flight and may play from the **white tees** if they chose to play in this flight. There was much discussion regarding the senior flight and the age and when we would start having these events. Based on a consensus of the membership in attendance, it was decided that 55 years of age designates you as a senior eligible to play starting with the Memorial event from the **white tees**. This includes all Roseville Golf Club events excluding NCGA qualifiers which must be played from the **blue tees**. It was also agreed that once you enter an event as a senior and play from the **white tees** your eclectic scores would be recorded in the senior flight even if you change your mind and decide to play from the **blue tees** in other events. The 54-hole net championship was also discussed and announced that the field low net would be the RGC Net Club Championship.

WEBMASTER – Posted Diamond tourney #1 on the RGC website, as all members of the Diamond Club are also members of RGC.

HANDICAP CHAIRMAN – All is well; nothing to report.

RULES CHAIRPERSON – Freida Aichele discussed and read the definition of abnormal ground conditions. A large discussion followed.
