President's Report – Dave Arellano: Dave called the meeting to order at 6:30pm. The David Oxley Tournament is on, date is Monday June 14th. There are 73 players that have committed to playing, projection is for up to 130 players. Many volunteers are needed, please contact Dave if you would be willing to help.

Vice President's Report –Paul Wilson: The shadowbox is updated with tournament results, and added contact names and numbers. It was suggested to add info on the Electic. The Christmas Party plans are on-going. The April Newsletter deadline is March 25th, board members are encouraged to send their reports to Paul.

Tournament Director's Report - Jesse Sierra: Mobile scoring has been working well. A bigger TV monitor was used and worked well. Signups for the 54-Hole Tourney is up to 16. Chris Annicella representing Golf Genius gave a report. The Certification Program is a walk-thru on how to use Golf Genius.

Handicap Chairperson's Report –Gary Krohn: There was discussion on Soft and Hard Cap. There are 27 members that are currently under the Soft Cap restriction. Gary contacted the NCGA and got their input on what it means to have the restrictions. It was decided to not lift the Soft Cap restriction.

Tournament Bookkeeper's Report –Harry Wharff: Payments have been made for the Chardonnay, Eagle Vines, and the Zone Qualifier tournaments.

Treasurer's Report –Jeff Blackmon: Jeff reports that account balances have been updated, monies have been allocated for the David Oxley Tournament, the general tournament fund and to the Savings account. \$10 per member payment needs to be transferred to the general tournament account.

Secretary's Report –Carl Mune: Since Feb 9th, there are five new members. Corrections on members' birthdays will alleviate the error in data entry, needs to be entered as 1/1/2000, then the members can go in and change their birth date. Harry needs the birth date of each member to verify for senior tournaments.

Webmaster's Report –Tim Turnquist: Tim reported that everything is updated and correct although there are some glitches in Member Planet. MP administrators have admitted to the glitches and are working to correct them.

Rules Chairperson –Ron Floyd: There was one infraction that occurred during the Zone Qualifier--a player putted first to show the line to another player. Also, there were issues with slow play during the Eagle Vines tournament. It would be helpful to distribute local rules to players prior to away tournaments.

Although it may be helpful to require players to score a double par for a "blow up" hole, thereby helping to speed up slow play--It was agreed to table this for now.
