

April 9, 2026, RGC Open Meeting Minutes

Called to Order: 6:30

The March Meeting Minutes have been approved and posted

Present: John Wharff, Harry Wharff, Scott Herman, Karry Przepiorski, Jim Espinoza, Steve Hendrickson, Jose Salcedo, Dan McCullough, Paul Wilson, David Bills, Yanni Lenakakis, Mike Rossiter, and eight RGC members.

President's Message: John welcomed attendees and thanked everyone for showing up. He shared that the updated by-laws approval vote will likely pass but he would wait for Tim to publish the results.

VP Message: Dan is working on the April Newsletter, so officers will email him their messages in the upcoming week. He also shared about the two scholarships for local high school golfers. He will send out an email so that more members can donate. The award winners will be recognized at the David Oxley Junior Golf Tournament.

Tournament Director: There are 65 players signed up for the Masters tournament and the weather will hopefully cooperate. There are 62 signed up for the Day on the Oaks #1 on Tuesday. Only 22 have signed up for the Plumas Lake Away tournament, but members can still sign up. Harry will no longer be sending out reminder emails for upcoming tournaments. The Golf Genius tournament platform will be eliminated in October due to increased costs, and RGC will once again return to Bluegolf because it will be free for the entire 2027 season. A question was raised regarding the need to update the Eclectic tournament on the website and Harry will look into it.

Tournament Bookkeeper and Treasurer's Report: All current bills are paid. RGC had budgeted \$3900 for the tournament platform for next year and it will not be needed after all.

Secretary's Report: Our membership now stands at 207 members. We have 40 new members joining us this year. Last year we finished with 210 members. 44 did not renew their membership; all of these numbers are consistent with what the club has experienced post-COVID. The good news is the club is experiencing high participation in tournaments as 140 have played in at least one tourney so far this year. The shadowbox is updated and will be used for club news and tournament information. Any notes placed in the shadowbox that are not related to that will be removed.

Webmaster's Report: Tim was absent but he has the website up to date minus recent requests from Harry.

Rule's Chairperson's Report: Steve said that there have been no rules problems in the latest tournaments. The local rules folded-card has been a big hit and used by many members. A question was brought up about the E-5 ruling and Steve responded that the club has been using it.

Handicapper's Report: Mike has the handicaps updated and the new Eclectic system has been running really smoothly.

Correspondence:

- Email from David Bills RE: custom hats as prizes for major tournaments; TB/Treasurer noted that they could be funded through the current budget with <\$100 net added cost.

Old Business:

- The updated Bylaws vote has been completed and the results will be shared soon.
- Harry - Software options; he's been in discussions with both NCGA (RE: Blue Golf) and Golf Genius regarding 2027 pricing for both. Currently anticipating that Golf Genius could be \$3,900+ to renew, while Blue Golf could be as low as ~\$2,500 (it's free this year, but there have been no pricing commitments for 2027 yet).
- Jim - Mentioned that it was previously discussed to do custom logo towels as tee prizes for this year's Invitational; he's going to bring confirmed options and pricing to the next meeting.

New Business

- The club is interested in receiving an update from the City of Roseville Parks and Recreation about improvement projects planned for the course. John will have Ron Floyd reach out to the department and invite them back to the September Open meeting.
- The NCGA Qualifiers are really expensive and the costs continue to rise. A question was raised about whether or not RGC should continue to send teams to these qualifiers. As a club that money could potentially be used for other membership opportunities. The Board cannot eliminate the club's participation but it can elicit a vote for the future of the club and these tournaments.
