Current funding for the Scholarship Fund is low. John suggested not having a raffle for the next tournament, instead make donations towards scholarship fund.

VP Message: Dan sent out the April Newsletter. A new email will be going out requesting donations for the Scholarship Fund. First Tee indicated there is only one candidate that met all the criteria for the Scholarship this year. Current funding for the scholarship is at \$320.00. Dan and Lori have discussed the menu for this year's Invitational Tournament meal. Lori is yet to get back to Dan with final costs. Discussed the need for raffle prizes, hats free foursome play DO or Woodcreek, Sierra View.

Tournament Director: There are 52 (26 teams) players signed up for the Senior 4-Ball tournament. Tuesday's DOTO #2 has 56 players signed up. Tournament Bookkeeper and Treasurer's Report: All tournaments through the 54-hole have been paid. All current bills are paid. Bill from South Valley due 6/4.
