

June 9, 2026, RGC Meeting Minutes

President's Message: John reviewed the David Oxley Tournament. Newsletter stuff to Dan to publish in July.

VP Message: Dan requested board members provide writeup for the July Newsletter by first week of July (in word format). On June 26 the scholarship will be awarded. Since it was Tom McCellhatton's idea to provide scholarships, Dan asked him to present the award, and he accepted. Dan might also attend the award ceremony. \$1000 will be awarded to the only person that qualified. RGC will have some representation at the meeting. Dan McCullough was winner of the DOTO #3 50/50 raffle. Discussed that for last year's Invitational meal there was only one complaint. The bread was too big. Suggestions were made to have dinner rolls or cut the buns in half.

Tournament Director: The Plumas Lake tournament had 33 players. Tournament went well, however we had more players than originally anticipated but the course was able to accommodate. It's early, but only three players have signed up for the firecracker so far. There was a problem at Plumas when someone won low gross from the whites. Tournament Guide was not explicit in stating that low gross can only be won from the blue tee. The change to the tournament guide stating that the provision also "includes away events". Harry to provide Tim change in tournament guide for publication. Jim E. had issues with accessing past tournament results in Golf Genius. This was due to the differences between the website portal and the mobile app.

Tournament Bookkeeper and Treasurer's Report: Plumas and DO #3 book money will be paid this week. Cashier's Check in the amount of \$1,000.00 (Scholarship money) was provided to First Tee during the Oxley event.

Secretary's Report: The membership total has remained the same as last month, 212 members. This is about the time where we offer anyone who signs up now to wait and begin membership in October. The shadowbox is updated.

Webmaster's Report: Tim has the website up-to-date with the exception of the Eclectic results, which needs one update. Tournament Handicaps will also be updated.

Rule's Chairperson's Report: Issue arose at the Plumas tournament where what looked like a "hazard" was not identified as one with red paint or stakes. Karry P. read USGA rule book that states that all ditches, lakes or marshes are hazards whether marked or not. Regardless, Harry reminded everyone that double par score is the maximum score that can be taken at away events.

Handicapper's Report: Mike has the handicaps updated and the new Eclectic system has been running really smoothly.

Correspondence: Ron Floyd forwarded the City of Roseville's email to the board members

Old Business:

- Jim - Mentioned that it was previously discussed to do custom logo towels as tee prizes for this year's Invitational; he's going to bring confirmed options and pricing to the next meeting.

- The red hazard stakes on the left side of Hole #4 are located inside the hazard area. Suggestion was made to define the hazard line with red paint.
