Handicapper's Message



Hello everybody!

We just finished the Club Championship and a lot of players were unsure how to adjust the holes for handicap differential. The following is information from the USGA Handicap System Manual. Hope this helps you understand it.

9-3. Assignment of Strokes
a. Where To Take Strokes

...”For formats in which handicap strokes are used on specific holes during the course of play (Match Play), a player generally takes them in the order assigned on the scorecard. For example, a player receiving three strokes takes them on the first, second, and third stroke holes.”... (“The Rules of Golf,” Rule 33-4).

So for Diamond Oaks, if you receive three strokes, those would be allocated on the number 1 (18th), 2 (9th) and 3 (12th) handicap holes.

We have three Eclectic Tournament events left; they are Past Presidents (November 2nd), Turkey Shoot (November 16th) and Eclectic Final (December 7th)

The tournament fund is in good financial shape with a little surplus retained to pay for office supplies, and any other expenses.

Thank you for including entry slips along with your payment when you enter a tournament. It makes my job much easier. Whether you enter via an entry slip or pay on PayPal, you may put notes of special circumstances on them such as who you want to play with (if possible), request an early or late tee time, or other comments. The tournament director will try to accommodate your request if possible.

A number of you are due prizes from previous tournaments. These are normally prizes from “away” golf tournaments, refunds of entry fees in tournaments in which you could not play, overpayments of entry fees, skins, etc. Note that any prizes won (Low Gross, Low Net, etc.) at Roseville Golf Club (RGC) home tournaments are posted to your account in the Diamond Oaks pro shop. I do not have those prize winnings.

A “Prizes Coming?” sheet is posted on the Bulletin Board or at the check-in table at each tournament listing those golfers who are playing in that particular tournament who have prizes due them. Check with me, the tournament director, or his designee at the conclusion of your golf round to receive your prize.

For those of you who do not play in many tournaments, check the quarterly Newsletter to see if your name is listed. Prizes that are over 6 months old and unredeemed may be forfeited to the tournament fund so it's important for you to check your Newsletter. If your name is listed, contact me and let me know how I can get the prize to you. My e-mail address is Corney1@starstream.net.

It is extremely important that you notify the tournament director at least 24 hours in advance if you cannot play in a particular tournament. Your entry fee will be refunded. However, except in emergencies, the entry fees cannot be refunded if notification is received within 24 hours of the tournament tee times.

At all RGC home tournaments the results are normally posted on our website (rosevillegolfclub.com) about a week after the conclusion of the tournament. However, these results are not "posted/paid" to your account for about 72 hours. This delay is to allow you time to review the results to ensure their accuracy. If you notice an error, immediately bring it to the tournament director's attention. It's extremely difficult to correct any errors once the amounts are posted and paid to the individual golfer's account.

I hope all of you are enjoying the club and your golf outings with your fellow RGC members. See you on the course!

SECRETARY'S MESSAGE



Well it is renewal time again. As of October 1st, we can start adding new members and they can play in the remaining tournaments for 2008 and all of the 2009 tournaments. New members can get some required rounds in for the NCGA Qualifying events coming up next year. Remember, join now, or join later, the membership is only good for the calendar year. If you have a friend that has been thinking about joining, now is the time to follow through. For those of you that pay for the Diamond Membership level, please see the Pro shop to get your member packet for that level.

With the larger membership base, and all of the payment options, Paul and I have had a very busy year. Please note the following and keep it in mind when you renew or pay for other events:

- ✓ If you pay by check, please make the payments for like items and don't combine them into one large payment. Tournament funds go to a different fund and it makes it difficult to keep track and transfer payments back and forth between accounts. You can pay for more than one tournament at a time, or you can pay for multiple memberships with one check, and also a number of Christmas party reservations with a single check, but please don't combine them all into one payment.
- ✓ Please renew early and keep track of your payment. Remember, there is a significant discount for renewing before the November 30th deadline. Around the end of November there will be a reminder to renew. If you renewed early and receive a call, please let me know so I can check your status to make sure the application did not get missed. There were some problems with Pay Pal last year that took some time to sort out as well as payments to the Pro Shop that were filed before I processed them.
- ✓ Please fill out your application in full. There are sometimes changes in phone, email, and address listings, and we need to verify that our current information is correct. Make sure you can receive email at the email address you give us. We get quite a few kickbacks from business addresses.
