We have even worked with a new RGC member who is a consultant to create a new link that will no longer require you to log in using the GGID. You will now be able to click the link, and it will direct you right to our Golf Genius Home page for all tee times and results (Event and Ringer).

Please have a look at the 2021 schedule and plan your travel for the away events and the rest of the schedule. We will play Eagle Vines Golf Course and Chardonnay in Napa in March, visit Rancho Murieta in July, and wrap the season up with Bayonet and Old Del Monte in Monterey in October. - 1. All entries will be handled online through Memberplanet, Zelle or Venmo. Please note on the form what tournament you are signing up for and who you would like to play with. You can also use the note or memo box to sign up for skins game, gross and/or net.
- 2. The prize fund will be handled the same way as before. The money won will be applied to the member's account at Diamond Oaks Golf shop.

HANDICAP CHAIRPERSON AND CLUB AMBASSADOR'S MESSAGE

Happy New Year everybody. I am the Handicap Chairperson and the Club Ambassador.

We have received the following message from NCGA regarding posting scores:

In order to improve data security and golfer privacy, golfers will need to create a digital profile to access the GHIN mobile app and ghin.com beginning in **January 2021**. Shared emails on multiple accounts will not be supported. Adult users are required to have a unique email address to create a digital profile for access to the GHIN products.

What does this mean? When you post a score online or through the NCGA App, you will no longer be able to access it using your GHIN. You will need to create a profile using your email address. There will be a grace period for a short time for the NCGA App and posting online through the NCGA browser. The only other way to post is through the kiosk at golf courses. However, because of COVID, not all golf courses have their kiosks available.

It is very important that you post the day that you play before midnight. There is a feature that factors in weather and course condition variables. The automated Playing Conditions Calculator (PCC) will analyze scores to determine if conditions of play differed significantly from "normal" to an extent that scoring was impacted. If so, all differentials for the day will be uniformly adjusted upwards or downwards. The calculation is performed each evening just before handicaps are updated. If a golfer delays posting, the score will inherit any PCC adjustment.

This is a reminder that all tournament scores are posted by the Handicap Committee.

Effective January 1, 2021, we will be returning to the Blue, Palmer and White tees. If you haven't already, please notify the Tournament Director and Handicap Chairperson if you wish to play the Palmer or White Tees.

RULES CHAIRPERSON

Hello RGC Members. Happy New Year and welcome to our new members! We pride ourselves at friendly competition with an active tournament schedule. To assure an even playing field and keep everything friendly, the USGA and RGC Local Rules are enforced at all tournaments. If you have played in tournaments before, you have probably made a bone-head error that has cost you a stroke or two. While the rules can be confusing, a little review can prevent mistakes. The USGA provides great resources at: www.usga.org/content/usga/home-page/rules-hub.html.

Our local rules are available on our RGC Website in the News Section and posted on the RGC bulletin board at Diamond Oaks. I also urge you to take a moment to review the playing procedures for each tournament. Varying course conditions will affect how local rules are applied to each tournament. And if you have questions, I and members of the RGC Rules Committee (RGCRC) are available at all tournaments.

Most playing procedure issues can be settled on the course by tapping into the experience in your playing group. But remember that players in a group cannot agree to ignore a RGC Rule. If there is a difference of opinion, there is an easy way to deal with it. Follow USGA Rule 20.1c (3)-Playing Two Balls When Uncertain What to Do. This protects your score, other competitors and keeps things moving. Just remember to declare to your group which ball you intend to score if allowed, putt out both balls, and notify the RGCRC immediately after the round. This is an important point. Any questions affecting a player's tournament score should always be brought to the attention of the RGCRC before signing the final scorecard.
