RGC Members,

I have replaced Jesse Sierra as Tournament Director for the rest of this year. I have worked with Jesse for the last several years and will try to be as efficient as he was getting out the tee sheets and the Payouts.

Please look at the 2025 schedule and plan your travel for the away events and the rest of the scheduled events.

I still have information as to who most of you like to play with, but please make sure you enter that on your entry form and/or contact me with any special requests.

Based on the list of players that have signed up, I create the tee sheets for all events. If you ever need an early or late time specifically, please submit that request with your entry, and I will try to accommodate you. Some of the major tournaments require that your tee time is based on score and will probably not be able to accommodate you for those tournaments after the first day.

- 1) We are going to a tee group scorecard, no more individual cards. The scorecards will be used to verify online scoring. We would like to have one player per group use the scoring app.
- 2) If you are having a hard time getting the app it is in the app store for your type of phone iPhone or Android, the app is Golfsoftware. Once you download the app you need to sign in to the software with our account using Rosevillegolfclub.golfclub.net once that is done you need to contact me to get your username and password at: rgcbkeeper@gmail.com or 916-599-5178.
- 3) Late entries past the deadline will be on the waitlist until a WD spot opens.
 - a. These late entries have been causing the course, TD, and Tournament handicapper several hours of extra work.
 - b. It would be better to sign up as early as possible and then WD, then to try to get in late.

Rules Chairperson Report

It is Summer and the course is in the best shape that I've seen it in many years. The traps are still an issue, but until they redesign the sprinkler system, we will continue to have wet and clumpy sand traps. It's too bad, because trap play is usually one of the differentiators of good players.

My job has been easy lately as there have been no rules issues and the pace of play at our tournaments has been very good and we haven't had to penalize any foursomes for slow play. That is ideal for the board


as we don't enjoy enforcing rules, but we will.

We have discussed the NCGA optional rule where a player can drop a lost or out of bounds ball at the edge of the fairway where their ball was last seen. From there they would be playing 4 off the tee. We will put this rule in play next year to speed up play. If you go back to the tee and hit another shot, you would still be laying three but perhaps be in the trees or hit another ball out of bounds.

Just a reminder that you now only have three minutes to locate your ball. The time starts when you arrive at the area where your ball landed, and you begin the search.

I will see you on the course and hopefully at the next open board meeting where we will vote in September.
